IS THERE? / ARE THERE?

Sobre el tema anterior para describir lo que hay en un lugar, también podemos formular preguntas. De la misma manera una es para preguntar por objetos singulares y el otro para objetos plurales. Las respuestas pueden ser cortas como en la imagen.

Short answers are used only with YES/NO questions.

EJEMPLOS:

1. Is there a stove in your kitchen? (hay una estufa en tu cocina?)
Yes, there is. No, there isn't

1. Are there many pictures in the bedroom? (hay muchas fotos en tu cuarto?)
Yes, there are No, there aren't

1. Is there a garage in the house? (hay una cochera en tu casa?)
Yes, there is No, there isn't

1. Are there flowers in the garden? (Hay flores en el jardín?)

Yes, there are No, there aren't
