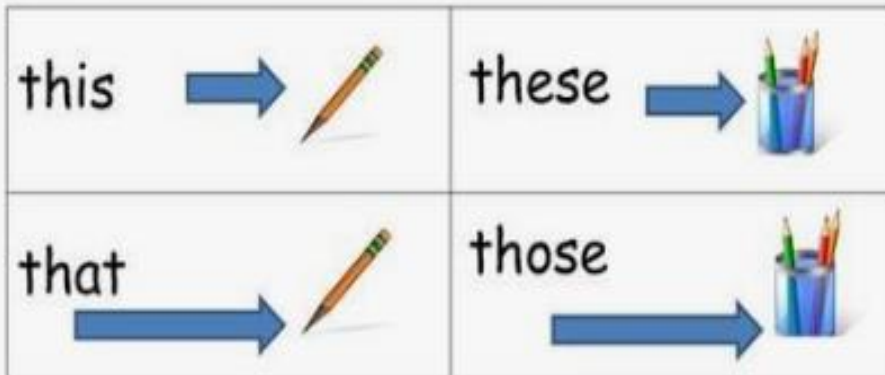

There **are** **books** on the desk.

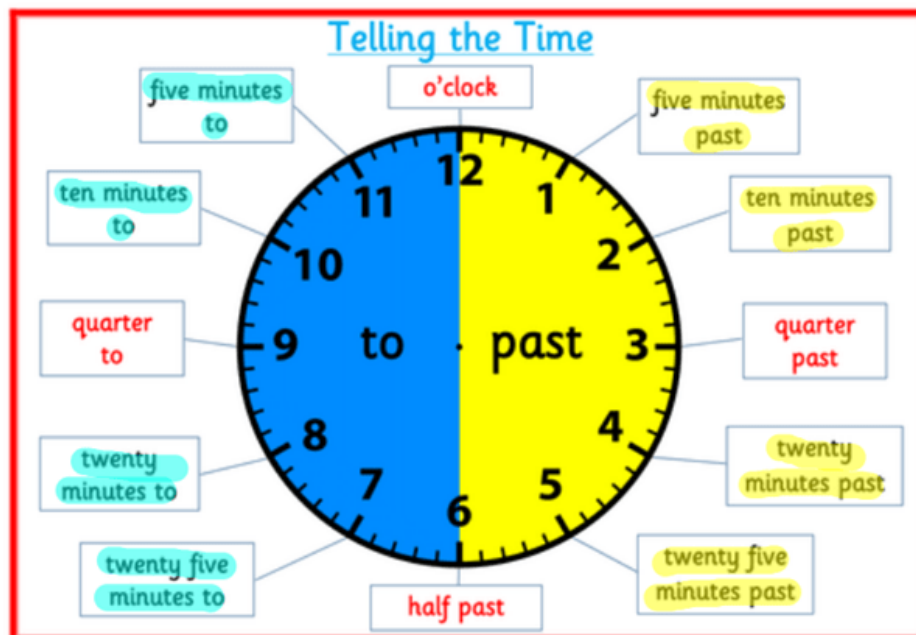
